- official high school transcript(s) through end of junior year, including an explanation of the grading scale, class rank, and grade point average
*Home school students should submit a transcript with curricula for grades 9 through 12.
- SAT I (SJC's code is 1697) or ACT (SJC's code is 1240)
- \$25 non-refundable application fee

Applying as a Transfer Student

Submit the following:

- completed application
- official high school transcript(s) and/or GED scores
- official college transcripts from all colleges you have attended
- \$25 non-refundable application fee

Applying as an International Student

Submit the following:

- completed application
- official secondary school transcript(s) in English with explanation of grading scale and external examination results
- if transferring from a university outside the United States, send an official college transcript(s) from all colleges you have attended to Educational Credential Evaluations, Inc. (ECE) or to World Education Services (WES). Request an official course-by-course evaluation to be sent to the Office of Admissions at Saint Joseph's College
- TOEFL results, if English is not your first language. Our code is 1697. ACT or SAT I results are required for scholarship consideration and will be accepted in place of the TOEFL.

Admission

Saint Joseph's College invites you to apply for admission by completing this application form. We are interested in you and the promise you represent and therefore consider each applicant on an individual basis, taking into account academic transcripts, test scores, extracurricular activities, and your personal promise.

Admission Process

Saint Joseph's College offers four admission-notification options. The Application for Admission and all required supporting credentials must be mailed to the Office of Admissions by the postmark deadline noted.

- October notification– October 15th postmark deadline
October 31st mail notification
- November notification– November 15th postmark deadline
November 30th mail notification
- December notification– December 1st postmark deadline
December 15th mail notification
- Standard notification– Rolling based on space availability

Students are strongly encouraged to apply early for priority consideration for financial aid. You must first complete the admission process to be considered for financial aid.

Admitted students are strongly encouraged to submit the \$200 enrollment deposit by March 1 in order to establish their priority for campus housing placement and to be eligible for registration for classes. The \$200 enrollment deposit is refundable by written request until May 1.

Financial Aid

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is required for consideration of scholarships, grants, and loans. The priority deadline for FAFSA submission is March 1. The school code for Saint Joseph's College is 001833.
