**S**aint Joseph's College Tennis is proud to offer a new and exciting program modeled after the professional league "World Team Tennis." Directed by Head Coach Reggie Sanderson, players will compete on co-ed teams in the following format:

- **Boys singles**
- **Girls singles**
- **Boys doubles**
- **Girls doubles**
- **Mixed doubles**

The league will kick-off with a practice Sunday, November 15th, and run a total of 10 weeks. There will be 8 weeks of regular season matches, and 2 weeks for playoffs.

Each team will play every Sunday; if there is a bye, that team will have a practice. Coach Sanderson will direct practices. Standings will be kept and e-mailed out each week.

### **Registration Options:**

**Option 1.** Free agent: Players register as an "individual" and are placed on a team. The free agent fee is \$90.

**Option 2.** Team registration: Players sign up as a group (4-8 players). The team fee is \$500.

Fee includes all matches and practices.

Option 2 is a discounted group rate and assures players of being with their friends or teammates. We encourage you to find a sponsor to pay your team fee. If choosing option 1, you will be placed on a team from your city or a "free agent" team if one is not available. Everyone gets to play.

## **F**ast **F**acts

- Teams will compete on Sunday nights from 6-9 p.m.
- Teams can be anywhere from 4-8 players, needing a minimum of 2 boys and 2 girls to compete in a dual match.
- Everyone present must play at least one position, no one ever sits out.
- Scoring will be total games, not matches. The idea is that every game counts, so a single game can make the difference in the total score.
- Teams will be divided by city.
- Many other schools and cities will be invited to compete as well as "free-agent" teams.
