



## ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT

If you wish to accept your Athletic Scholarship, please sign, date and return a copy of this document to Student Financial Services. Your acceptance means that you also accept the provisions listed herein and agree to abide by them.

1. The scholarship is for one year. The amount of your scholarship is listed on your Financial Aid Award Letter.
2. Half of the amount will be extended for the first semester and the other half for the second semester. To be eligible for the scholarship in either semester, the recipient must be a full-time student in that semester.
3. The scholarship is for the regular two-semester school year at SJC and cannot be used to meet expenses for shorter terms or sessions. The College furthermore assumes no obligation for expenses incurred by the recipient for off-campus tuition, room or board.
4. The scholarship is made in accordance with the rules of the NCAA. A summary of those terms and conditions are listed below.
5. In addition to the NCAA rules, the recipient also agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of Saint Joseph's College and those of the Athletic Conferences to which it belongs:
  - a. Must be eligible to participate in intercollegiate athletics according to the regulations in the College Catalog
  - b. Will be required to contribute services in athletic related events
  - c. If injury prevents the recipient from participating in athletics, he/she will substitute contributed services for team participation

### SUMMARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE NCAA

1. Any renewal of the grant-in-aid award shall be made on or before July 1 prior to the academic year it is to be effective.
2. Maximum permissible financial aid may not exceed "commonly accepted educational expenses."
3. A student-athlete may not receive financial assistance other than that administered by the institution except that financial assistance may be received from anyone upon whom the student-athlete is naturally or legally dependent.
4. When unearned financial aid is awarded to a student and athletic ability is taken into consideration in making the award, such aid combined with other aid the student-athlete may receive from employment during semester or term time, other scholarships and grants-in-aid (including governmental grants for educational purposes) and like sources, may not exceed commonly accepted educational expenses.

#### Institutional aid may not be gradated or terminated during the period of award:

1. Because of the recipient's athletic ability or his contribution to a team's success.
2. Because an injury prevents the recipient from participating in athletics.

#### Institutional aid may be gradated or terminated during the period of its award if the recipient:

1. Does not satisfy the stated institutional academic requirement for like scholarships or grants-in-aid.
2. Voluntarily renders himself ineligible for intercollegiate athletic competition.
3. Fraudulently misrepresents any information on his application.
4. Engages in serious misconduct warranting substantial disciplinary penalty by the appropriate institutional committee or agency. (Serious misconduct includes manifest disobedience through violation of institutional regulations or established athletic department policies and rules applicable to all student-athletes).
5. Voluntarily withdraws from the sport at any point during the period of the award.

#### Such gradation or termination of any award may occur if:

1. The action is taken by the institution's regular disciplinary and/or awards authority.
2. The student-athlete has had opportunity for a hearing.
3. The action is based on institutional policy applicable to the general student body.
